Drake Water Reclamation Facility South Process Train Upgrades Complete

Fort Collins, CO --- February 15, 2016:

The Drake Water Reclamation Facility (DWRF) South Process Train (SPT) began serving the Fort Collins community on November 11, 2015. The wastewater treatment plant's south process train was upgraded to include a three-stage BNR with anoxic, anaerobic and aeration basins. The project also included equipment upgrades and replacements such as mixed liquor pumps, aeration blowers and IT equipment.

The upgrades to the existing Drake Water Reclamation Facility will help the treatment plant to continue serving the entire city of Fort Collins. An emphasis on schedule and budget management, quality, functionality, safety, and risk management led to the project being completed ahead of schedule and under budget.
