MAX BRT Project Receives ENR “Best Projects 2014” Award of Merit

Fort Collins, CO --- November 10, 2014: Ditesco, a full-service engineering, program, project, and construction management firm, is proud to announce that the MAX Bus Rapid Transit System (BRT) project in Fort Collins, Colorado has received the “2014 Best Projects Award of Merit” from Engineering News-Record (ENR). This award program seeks to honor great construction projects and the teams that brought the projects to life. The MAX BRT project received the award in the “Airports/Transit” category.

This environmentally friendly form of public transportation is the first of its kind in Northern Colorado, and one of the first BRT systems in the state. It features 19 bus stations, a new guideway and bridge, a new transit center, an expanded maintenance facility and a new overpass and underpass.

The MAX BRT runs north-south through the central core of Fort Collins, with the objective of connecting multiple parts of the city using an exclusive route of partially dedicated guideway and mixed use roads.

The MAX BRT system has been continually exceeding ridership expectations since opening day on May 10, 2014.
