# Fort Collins' new Foothills mall to open Nov. 13

FORT COLLINS -- Foothills, the rebuilt shopping mall in midtown Fort Collins, announced Wednesday that it will open for business Nov. 13.

The grand-opening festivities will kick off at 6 p.m. on that Friday evening, according to a press release from Alberta Development Partners, which has been rehabilitating and reimagining the old Foothills Mall at South College Avenue and Foothills Parkway that opened in 1973.

Foothills' opening festivities will include a Christmas tree lighting, free pictures with Santa Claus, local musical performances, food samples from Foothills restaurants and raffles and giveaways, the release said.

According to the mall's website, [www.shopfoothills.com](http://www.shopfoothills.com), Foothills will feature shops such as H&M, Nordstrom Rack, Sports Authority, Vans, Gymboree and White House/Black Market. Restaurants will include Grimaldi's, C.B. & Pott's, Bar Louie, Bad Daddy's Burger Bar, Longhorn Steakhouse and Smashburger.

The mall also will have a Cinemark XD theater.

The website promises "traditional indoor retail, street-front shops, open-air eateries and outdoor amenities." Foothills will feature amenities such as a grand fountain and

dancing fountains, a skating pond, pavilion, parks and valet parking, the website says.

During the yearslong construction, several stores have remained open, including Bath & Body Works, Macy's, Maurice's, Zumiez and Payless Shoe Source.
